

March 2013 PASTORAL COUNCIL MINUTES  
(3/18/2013, 6:15-7:25 PM, C+CC Sanctuary)

Fr. Kacerguis opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes and Chair report (P. Kraus):

Pastor's Report (Fr. Kacerguis):

- Discussions with the Diocese regarding a permanent deacon for the Chapel.

Newman Fellowship Report (K. Flynn):

Old Business:

New Business:

- (Fr. Kacerguis): need for approximately 20 servers for the Agape meal on Holy Thursday.
- (B. Webster): woodworking interest and Christmas ornament sales for St. James School project of food drive, to be accompanied by other parishioners. This would need to be coordinated with the Commission on Social Justice, e.g., aiming for the second week of Advent in the upcoming December.
- (All): other parishes with large scale, big-event fundraisers; such an event at the C+CC would need extensive planning.
- Ongoing recruitment for new members, particularly among parishioners not previously associated with the Council. Including student graduations/rotation of RPI Catholic student organizations, will need to look for at least four replacement members.
