Chair Report:

• Approval of February 11, 2009 minutes with a minor correction. No March 2009 minutes were available as the Pastoral Council attended the Lenten Wednesday series. Mr. Crone will incorporate the February minutes and send them to Jill Wishon for posting on the C+ CC web site.

Pastor's Report:

- Lenten Wednesdays speaker series, with high-profile speakers and increased attendance, particularly from outside parishes. To involve such speakers, planning must occur early, e.g., this year's slate was organized by September 2008, with honoraria and travel expenses.
- Holy Week went well, with increased attendance noted at services. One item of interest was that at the 5 PM Easter Sunday, approximately nine families were in attendance with their RPI students.
- Pastoral planning I. Many regular participants at Christ Sun of Justice celebrated Easter at other Troy parishes before they close as part of the "Called to be Church" process. The impact of the consolidation will be noted as part of annual renewal of registration in the fall.
- Pastoral planning II. Social justice and faith formation efforts are ongoing as parish linkages become
 more formalized. Christ Sun of Justice and Our Lady of Victory have been in discussion regarding
 Mass scheduling to ensure coverage of the two linked parishes.
- Pastoral planning III. Catholic schools in the Troy area, such as at Our Lady of Victory, are under enrollment and budget constraints.
