Luke depicts Jesus in his short-lived ministry as deeply compassionate for all, especially those who were rejected or diminished in value by their society - the poor, the oppressed, and the marginalized of that culture, such as Samaritans, Gentiles, and women. Some of Jesus' most powerful parables are uniquely recorded in Luke: The Good Samaritan, The Rich Fool, The Prodigal Son, The Rich Man and Lazarus, The Persistent Widow, and The Pharisee and the Tax Collector. Luke describes Jesus on the road, healing and teaching, a journey that climaxes on the road to Emmaus. Luke's Jesus continues on a journey with us throughout our lives. Godspeed.

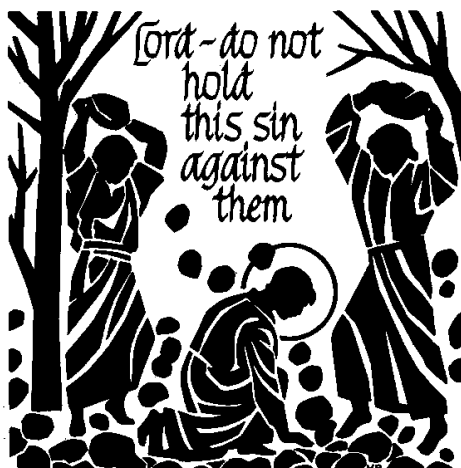
